Carbon Gold was established to help promote the use of biochar in mitigating against climate-change and to support sustainable food production through the development of biochar-based products which both remove carbon dioxide from the atmosphere and improve soil fertility.

We are committed to promoting healthier soil and sustainable growing whilst continually exploring ways to have a positive impact on our planet with a focus on sustainable development (meeting the need of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meeting their own needs) as a guiding principle within our business. Concern for the environment is an integral and fundamental part of this commitment and our aim is to reduce the impact on the environment from our operations.

This is reflected in our policy of only using natural ingredients and even up-cycling organic waste by-products where possible such as the wood waste materials that are used to produce biochar or coir which is the fibre extracted from the discarded outer husk of coconuts in the production of our products; whilst continually exploring ways to reduce reliance on landfill by working towards more sustainable packaging materials.

Continually assessing the environmental impact of our operations and setting objectives in order to improve our environmental performance. We will:

- Promote responsibility for the environment within the organisation and communicate and implement this policy at all levels within the workforce.
- Reduce the use of energy, water, and other resources.
- Minimise waste by reduction, re-use, and recycling methods.
- Ensure that our policies and operations are developed in a way that is complementary to this policy.
- Not prioritise profit needs ahead of the sustainable development ideal.
- Encourage suppliers to commit to the sustainable development philosophy.
